Local Eagle Scout Project Expands Personal Care Library at The Community at Rockhill

WHAT: The Community at Rockhill (“Rockhill”) has been chosen as the subject of an Eagle Scout Project by local Souderton High School senior Stephen Keller of Boy Scout Troop 16.* During the month of September, Stephen has conducted a book collection and fundraiser to support an expansion of Rockhill’s [Personal Care](#) (PC) library. In addition to many book drop-offs, Stephen used the monetary donations to purchase new bookshelves, which he will now **lead a group of his fellow Scouts to assemble, place and fill on campus**. Any surplus funds from Stephen’s project will be contributed to Rockhill’s Benevolent Care Fund.

**Stephen Keller is the son of Pamela Keller, Rockhill’s Personal Care Administrator, who oversees most operations of the Personal Care (or Assisted Living) level of the community’s care continuum.*
